Southern Power announced the acquisition of its 29th solar project and fourth in the state of Texas — the 200-megawatt (MW) Millers Branch Solar Facility from EDF Renewables in September 2023. In May 2024, Southern Power announced the expansion of Millers Branch Solar Facility. The Phase II expansion represents an additional 180-megawatts (MW).

Southern Power will lead the continued development and construction of Millers Branch.

Phase I of the project is expected to achieve commercial operation in the fourth quarter of 2025. Once operational, the electricity and associated renewable energy credits generated by the 200 MW facility will be sold under a 20-year virtual power purchase agreement with Thermo Fisher Scientific, which uses the renewable energy certificates to drive progress toward its net zero-by-2050 commitment.

Phase II of the project is Branch. Phase II is expected to achieve commercial operation in the second quarter of 2026. Cisco, Juniper Networks, IDEXX, Cadence, Bio-Rad, PTC and a large healthcare company with support from Sustainability Roundtable Inc., as members of the Net Zero Consortium for Buyers, each signed power purchase agreements with Southern Power for, in the aggregate, all the environmental attributes, such as renewable energy credits (RECs), produced by the 180 MW Phase II portion of the Millers Branch Solar Facility.
